Crapo Statement at Executive Session to Organize for the 118th Congress February 9, 2023

Washington, D.C.--U.S. Senator Mike Crapo (R-Idaho), Ranking Member of the U.S. Senate Finance Committee, delivered the following remarks at an executive session to organize for the 118th Congress.
