FREE IMPORTATION OF STAINED GLASS FOR ST. JOSEPH'S CATHEDRAL, HARTFORD, CONN., AND FOR THE CHURCH OF ST. FRANCIS XAVIER OF PHOENIX, ARIZ.

Mr. BYRD of Virginia, from the Committee on Finance, submitted the following

R E P O R T

[To accompany H.R. 7431]

The Committee on Finance, to whom was referred the bill (H.R. 7431) to provide for the free entry of certain stained glass for St. Joseph's Cathedral, Hartford, Conn., and for the Church of St. Francis Xavier, of Phoenix, Ariz., having considered the same, report favorably thereon without amendment, and recommend that the bill do pass.

PURPOSE

The purpose of H.R. 7431 is to provide for the entry, free of duty, of certain stained glass or prefabricated panels consisting of stained glass set in reinforced concrete with fastening devices imported for use in St. Joseph's Cathedral, Hartford, Conn., and in St. Francis Xavier Church and auxiliary buildings, Phoenix, Ariz.

GENERAL STATEMENT

H.R. 7431 would direct the Secretary of the Treasury to admit free of duty any stained glass or any prefabricated panels consisting of stained glass set in reinforced concrete with fastening devices imported on and after July 1, 1960, and prior to January 1, 1963, for use in the construction of St. Joseph's Cathedral in Hartford, Conn., and imported before the date of the enactment of the bill for use in the construction of St. Francis Xavier Church and auxiliary buildings in Phoenix, Ariz. The bill also provides for a refund of duties paid on any entries covering such articles whether the same were liquidated prior to the date of enactment of this bill or on or after such date.

Public hearings were held by the Committee on Finance on this bill on June 15, 1962.
