Res. 133) "Authorizing the granting of insurance under the act entitled 'An act to authorize the establishment of a Bureau of War-Risk Insurance in the Treasury Department,' approved September second, nineteen hundred and fourteen, as amended by the act approved October sixth, nineteen hundred and seventeen, on application by a person other than the person to be insured," having met, after full and free conference, have agreed to recommend and do recommend to their respective Houses as follows:

That the Senate recede from its disagreement to the amendments of the House and agree to the same.
