Motion to Commit With Instructions

Mr. HATCH moves to Commit the bill H.R. 933 to the Committee on Finance of the Senate with instructions to report the same back to the Senate forthwith with the following amendment:

(1) Strike section 1522 and insert legislative language providing for a 5-year reauthorization of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program (TANF) that, in addition to providing improved transparency in terms of TANF spending and better coordination with other human services programs, includes provisions to strengthen the current TANF work requirements by accelerating job placement rates for recipients of TANF assistance or benefits, continuing to reduce the number of families who need to receive TANF assistance or benefits, and improving State flexibility while increasing accountability, and vitiates the need for the Secretary of Health and Human Services to waive current TANF work requirements.
