This resolution requests the Tariff Commission to immediately initiate and carry out an investigation under the provisions of section 336 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, with respect to the china table and kitchen articles specified in paragraph 212 of the Tariff Act of 1930.

It is the opinion of your committee that a comparative cost of production study covering chinaware in the United States and Japan will be exceedingly helpful in negotiating future trade agreements on such products.
