8 Hon. Daniel Patrick Moynihan (Chairman of the Committee)
9 presiding.

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1 The Chairman. A very good morning to our most
2 distinguished witness. With us is the First Lady on the
3 occasion of this extraordinary week of testimony on the
4 Health Security Act of 1993.

5 This is a regular meeting of the Committee on
6 Finance, and with the indulgence of our witness may I say
7 that a quorum is present and we have before us the
8 nominations sent to us by the President of Mr. Jeffrey
9 Garten to be Under Secretary for National Trade at the
10 Department of Commerce; Dr. Mary Jo Bane, to be Assistant
11 Secretary for Family Support at the Department of Health
12 and Human Services; George Munoz, to be Assistant
13 Secretary for Management and Chief Financial Officer of
14 the Department of Treasury; June Gibbs Brown, to be
15 Inspector General of the Department of Health and Human
16 Services; Dr. Shirley Sears Chater, to be Commissioner of
17 Social Security; and Herbert Chabot, to be Judge of the
18 United States Court.

19 I'd like to propose that these be voted on en banc.
20 If there are any persons who wish to be recorded.

21 The Republican Leader?

22 Senator Dole. Was Mr. Garten in that group?

23 The Chairman. Mr. Garten is first on the list.

24 Senator Dole. I don't have any comment, except that
25 I may make a further comment on the floor, because of his

1 views on agriculture.

2 The Chairman. Yes, sir.

3 Mr. Grassley, did you have something?

4 Senator Grassley. I've stated my views on the same
5 matter.

6 The Chairman. Mr. Conrad?

7 Senator Conrad. I would want to include myself in
8 that category and reserve rights on the floor until we can
9 get things suitably worked out with Mr. Garten.

10 The Chairman. Without objection, that is understood.

11 All in favor will say aye.

12 (A chorus of ayes.)

13 The Chairman. Those opposed?

14 (No audible response.)

15 The Chairman. The vote is unanimous and the
16 nominations will be sent to the floor directly.

17 (Whereupon, at 10:06, the meeting was concluded.)

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
