Your committee having had under consideration Senate bill 5517, beg leave to report it and to recommend its passage, with the following amendments:

On page 1, line 3, strike out all after the enacting clause and all on

page 2, and insert the following:

That the second paragraph of section one of the war-risk insurance act is hereby

amended to read as follows:

"That until such time as the Secretary of the Treasury may direct otherwise and

subject to the provisions of section nine hereof, there shall be in such bureau a Division of Marine and Scamen's Insurance and a Division of Military and Naval Insurance."

Sec. 2. That hereafter all payments of military and naval family allowances provided for in the said war risk insurance act shall be made upon and in accordance with awards by the Director of the Bureau of War Risk Insurance, and all laws inconsistent with the said war statement of the said war statement of the said war statement.
